In 1978, John Pennachetti, Sr. and his son Leonard planted some of Niagara's first European varieties at Cave Spring Vineyard, located high up on a terrace of the Niagara Escarpment overlooking Lake Ontario known as the Beamsville Bench. The site caught their attention for its gentle slope and stony, limestone-rich soils, holding great promise for cool-climate viticulture. In 1986, together with winemaker Angelo Pavan, the family founded Cave Spring Cellars. With an international reputation for its age-worthy Rieslings, Cave Spring is also known for outstanding Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc, among other cool-climate varieties.

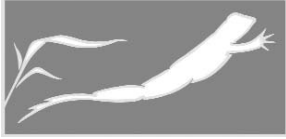

*Opens beautifully, balanced on malt, peat and young spirit. The youth and strength of the spirit infusing the aromas of green apple, mild mint, clove, bayleaf and forest greenwood. Given a dash of water and time. Little notes of meadowsweet, iris and honeysuckle put their head above the parapet but don't linger too long as the next wave of bracken and smoke with a slipstream of vanilla is about to overload the olfactory senses. The madeira cask influence lies deep in the glass and brings the rich notes of syrupy dates and raisins which hold up well to the onslaught.*

**PC7 Cask Strength**

(6 x 700mL)

*The third release of the port charlotte islay single malt, distilled at the bruichladdich distillery in 2001. Again from the same vintage stocks, this time bottled in october 2008, the whisky is now Seven years of age. Now the natural cask strength has fallen to 61%, the spirit becoming more Compelling all the time.*

## X4

Islay, Scotland

The new spirit X4 was recreated in 2008 by distilling director Jim McEwan at Islay's Bruichladdich distillery, before being reduced to a less perilous 50% ABV at bottling. "X4 has loads of flavour, it's no mere vodka substitute. It's the original usquebaugh, the spirit of the Vikings that our forefathers knew. They didn't wait to mature it, nor did we. It's a little bit of history – so savour the flavour."

*The first quadrupled pot still distillation in 300 years; un-peated barley distilled and bottled on Islay.*



Hangar One changes the whole idea of what vodka is. The vodka is “insanely great” because they make it in an incredibly old-fashioned hands-on way. Only real fruit is used with no additives, and all the vodkas are pot-distilled. The results are vodkas that both 1) taste great and 2) keep their quality after you opened the bottle.

<i>Jorg Rupf and Lance Winters figured out how to make straight vodka taste good. First they pot-distill a vodka from expensive viognier wine. Then they blend it into an excellent column still wheat vodka. Here's the magic: there's no harsh alcoholic smell or taste, just soft beautiful purity.</i>

<i>Totally fresh tangerines in the infusion, with fresh tangerine flowers added. It's like peeling an actual tangerine, a really good one: the tiny spray of oil that comes up from your thumbnail is exactly what our vodka smells and tastes like.</i>

<b>"Kaffir Lime"</b>	(6 x 750mL)	54866
<i>Unusual &amp; knobbly Indonesian lime. We use the leaves too – they are the ones you see in Thai cuisine. Great fresh lime taste, without any of that artificial overtones that spoil so many lime products.</i>

<b>"Fraser River Raspberry"</b>	(6 x 750mL)	783423
<i>From upper Washington state, the Meeker raspberry makes a startlingly fresh-tasting vodka. We make only one batch a year, in June, when the berries are ripe.</i>		
<b>"Spiced Pear"</b>	(6 x 750mL)	168583
<i>This vodka is an artistic/technical tour-de-force: beautifully focused &amp; very clean, with the pear aroma and flavor tastefully subdued, so you actually enjoy it as a vodka. It's perfect chilled &amp; straight up: classic martini. There's a lovely subtle clove overtone.</i>
