The first railroad line in Chile was founded in 1851 by American businessman William Wheelwright and his company, the Pacific Steam Navigation Company. The railroad connected with the north-south route, to the small port town of Pichilemu, stopping at a dozen train stations along the way, including the Colchagua Station at the middle of the route. When this east-west branch in the Colchagua Valley began construction it was a major turning point in civilizing this rough countryside. The wines from Estación (Spanish for "station") were named in honor of the Colchagua Station, which is now a historical landmark and borders the property of the Estación vineyards.

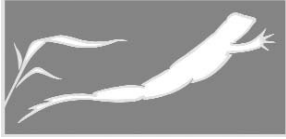
