Taltarni's diverse collection of wines expresses the distinctive regional terroir of its vineyards. Crafted with expertise, Taltarni wines stay true to the inspiration of founder John Goelet, who established Taltarni in order to produce exceptional wines in Australia using traditional French winemaking methods.

2009 Taltarni Brut Tache

Taltarni is renowned for its exceptional sparkling wines. Blended from fruit from its vineyards in the Pyrenees and finished with parcels of fruit from the Clover Hill vineyard in Tasmania, these vintage méthode traditionnelle wines have exquisite length and flavour. Taché, the French term for "stained", refers to the rare winemaking method used since 1985 by Taltarni to create this fine lightly tinted sparkling wine. Made from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, the delicate salmon pink hue is achieved by adding a hint of red wine liqueur to the finished tirage wine at disgorgement. Taltarni Brut Taché has gained a reputation for its elegant style.

Sourced from fruit of Victoria's cooler climate vineyards, Taltarni's T Series Shiraz highlights a variety Taltarni is well renowned for with its exceptional fruit structure, deep colour and vibrant assortment of flavours.

Grapes for the Taltarni Three Monks Cabernet Merlot 2006 were sourced entirely from Taltarni's Pyrenees vineyard. 2006 was a dry, warm vintage with lower yields producing ripe, concentrated fruit that was harvested two weeks earlier than expected. Cabernet and Merlot are classic blending partners with the Cabernet providing length and structure and the Merlot adding softness and mid-palate weight. A small amount of Petit Verdot has been included for added richness and texture.

Taltarni first produced the Pyrenees Shiraz in 1977. Taltarni's Pyrenees Shiraz is an exquisite wine crafted using Taltarni's finest winemaking methods. Small wine parcels are cool fermented to retain fresh fruit characters, with the wine undergoing extended skin contact to enhance the complexity of the wine and soften tannins. 10% of the wine undergoes end of ferment in barrel integrating subtle oak, cedar and spice characteristics. The wine then matures about 18 months in 60% new oak, mainly French barriques with about 10% in American oak.

The first railroad line in Chile was founded in 1851 by American businessman William Wheelwright and his company, the Pacific Steam Navigation Company. The railroad connected with the north-south route, to the small port town of Pichilemu, stopping at a dozen train stations along the way, including the Colchagua Station at the middle of the route. When this east-west branch in the Colchagua Valley began construction it was a major turning point in civilizing this rough countryside. The wines from Estación (Spanish for “station”) were named in honor of the Colchagua Station, which is now a historical landmark and borders the property of the Estación vineyards.

2010 Estación Chardonnay

Aromas of tropical pineapple as well as notes of pears, peaches and melons. This Chardonnay has great depth and volume with a good balance and crispy acidity.

2010 Estación Shiraz

Smooth tannins deliver voluminous body, accompanied by a balanced acidity that greatly highlights the fruitful expression of this variety.

2010 Estación Carmenere

The smooth and mature tannins leave a velvety sensation on the palate. Rich and elegant flavours of caramel and red fruit linger pleasingly.

The Estampa vineyards are located in the heart of the Colchagua Valley, just a few meters from the renowned Colchagua wine train. Each plot of land has been planted with vines especially chosen for the Colchagua terroir and trained to a vertical shoot positioned trellis. Estampa has 300 hectares of vineyard divided among three areas, planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Carménère and Syrah. These grapes serve as the base for the assemblages. The vineyards also include blocks of Malbec, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Petit Syrah and Viognier to increase the character and complexity of the wines.

ESTATE SERIES

2009 Estate Viognier/Chardonnay, Colchagua Valley

85% Viognier and 15% Chardonnay. This assemblage shows the synergy of the two varietals with a vibrant acidity and freshness. On the palate there are notes of apricots and custard apple from the Viognier and green apple and honey from the Chardonnay.

2009 Estate Syrah/Cabernet, Colchagua Valley

85% Syrah and 15% Cabernet. Medium concentration with dense and juicy tannins, highlighted by black tea, cherry marmalade and raspberry.

2009 Estate Malbec/Petite Sirah, Colchagua Valley

60% Malbec and 40% Petite Sirah. This assemblage has an interesting combination of fresh, clean fruit from the Malbec, combined with the more dense and mature aromas and flavors of the Petite Sirah. The barrel aging shows in the background with notes of mocha and vanilla, adding balance to the fruit. This is a powerful wine with freshness and balance.

RESERVE SERIES

2006 Reserve Sauvignon Blanc “Assemblage”, Casablanca Valley

Aromas of cut grass, fresh figs and herbaceous tones from the Sauvignon Blanc, with notes of citrus, green apple and pear from the Chardonnay. Ripe apricots notes from the Viognier component carry though on the palate, creating a wine with great aromatic characteristics, dominated by the Sauvignon Blanc.

GOLD SERIES

2004 Gold Syrah, Colchagua Valley

A blend of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Malbec. This full-bodied wine has excellent structure that fuses the dense tannins with the toasted vanilla notes which are the result of barrel aging. A long finish with accents of caramel and wild berries.

A lively nose of papaya, mango, grapefruit, violet and liquorice. A complex and unctuous mouth, lifted by a refreshing minerality and a crispy, intense fruit finish.

A nice structure with round tannins, it develops diverse aromatic dimensions offering flavours of jasmine, rose and blackberry.

2007 Chateauneuf-du-Pape

94 Points, Wine Advocate #185 (Oct 2009)

The 2007 Chateauneuf du Pape, which Barruol purchases from select vigneron, is dominated by Grenache, but it includes at least 30% Mourvedre and a small quantity of Cinsault. A dense purple color is accompanied by a ripe nose of red and black fruits, Christmas fruitcake, spice box, garrigue, and pepper. Rich and full-bodied with moderate tannin, good acidity, and a layered, intense mouthfeel, it will benefit from 2-3 years of cellaring, and should age for 15+ years.

Le Paradou is a custom cuvee created in partnership with the Chaudiere family of Chateau Pesquie, drawing from old vine parcels near the town of Apt, bordering on the Cotes du Ventoux appellation. The vines, ranging in age between 40 and 60 years old, are cultivated in accordance with the laws of Terra Vitis, an organization that ensures that properties respect the environment in which the vines are grown and stresses the benefits of integrated farming. The name of the cuvée comes from a centuries-old farmhouse situated in one of the most lovely areas of Provence, right on the estate of Chateau Pesquie.

2009 Viognier

On the nose; white flowers and white fruits such as peach and apricot. The palate is very fresh and balanced, with green apple, apricot aromas and a touch of mango.

2009 Grenache

On the nose you have very expressive fresh berries and typical peppery spices. The palate shows a balanced structure, with a good freshness and very elegant round tannins.

DOMAINE TIER

Purely Mediterranean, these wines embody the Domaine's style of balance, elegance and complexity. They are produced as AOC Coteaux du Languedoc and also include a CARIGNAN coming from 50 year old vines.

2010 Rose

A lush and lively wine with an appealing soft rose colour and violet hints. Its bouquet develops intense aromas of delicate peony, raspberry, clementine and violet candy notes. The palate is smooth, round and well balanced with a lingering finish. Vibrant, crisp and dry, this rosé embodies the finesse style and spirit of the domaine.

2007 Carignan

Our Carignan Vieilles Vignes is truly a Mediterranean wine. This long forgotten Languedoc grape variety re-finds its unique character in this limited production cuvée. Its bouquet is intense and develops perfumes of small red fruit, black olives and wild Mediterranean herbs.

2007 AOC Coteaux du Languedoc Rouge

This wine is deep garnet in color, with fragrant aromas of blackberries, bilberries (European blueberries) and spices. The distinctive herbal notes commonly found in wines around the Mediterranean called garrigue—lavender, sage, rosemary and wild thyme—speak to the wine's regionality and terroir. The palate is well-balanced and clean, becoming round and full-bodied, with soft, ripe tannins and a long finish.
